About the Project

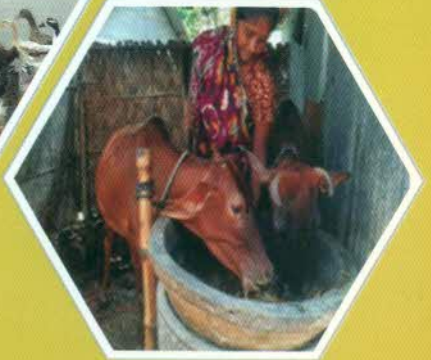
The project is focusing on Host Community in Ukhiya, Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. The geographical setting of the targeted communities is Rohingya adjacent Host Communities that are interacting with Rohingya households regularly for live and livelihoods purposes.

Project Goal

Improving livelihood situations & peace building of the hosting communities in Ukhiya, Cox's Bazar.

Overall Objective

To improve the capacities of 1,000 families of host communities on food production and income generating activities towards employment generation and increased income.



Project Location

The project location is situated at two unions (Palong Khali and Raja Palong) of Ukhiya upazila (sub-district), Cox's Bazar district.

Beneficiaries

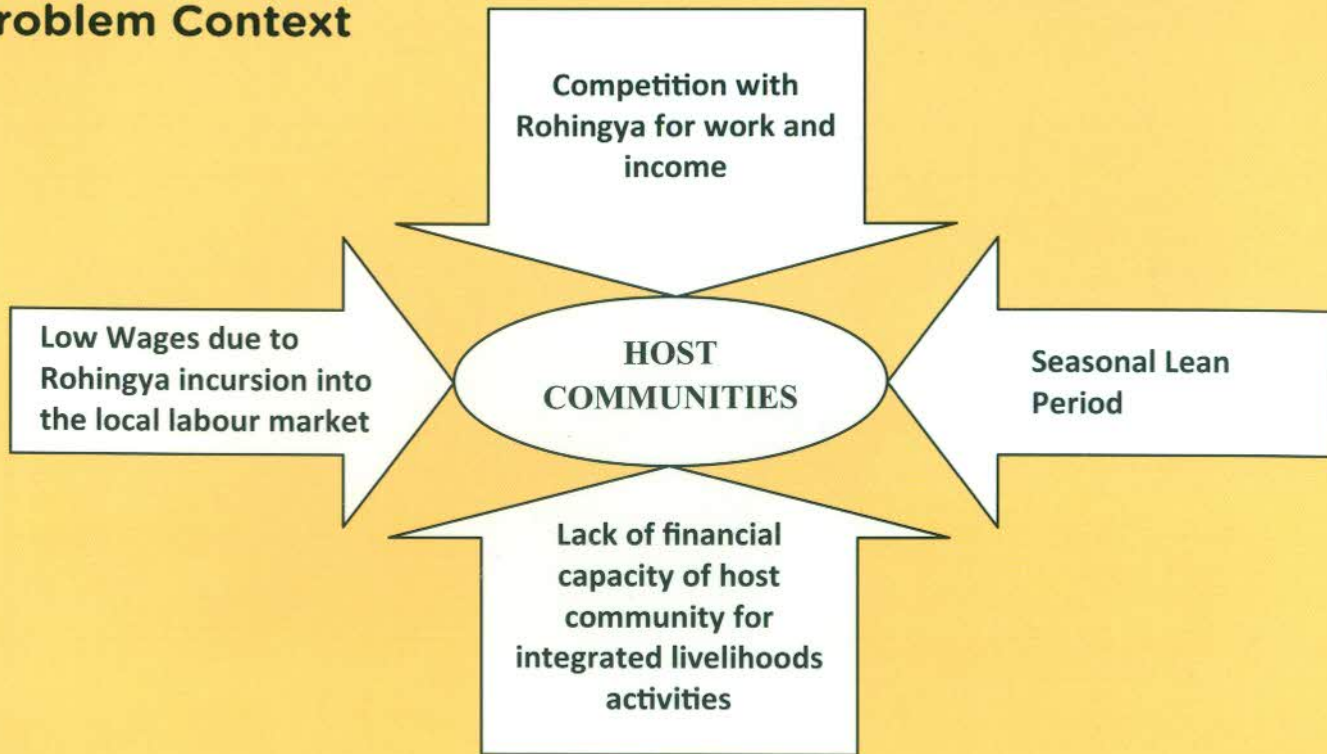
The project targeted direct beneficiaries are 1,000 Host Families. Indirect beneficiaries are about 20,000 Host Community individuals.

Pressure Group

The initial situation is that around 1,100,000 Rohingyas are living at the camps, among the host community houses and their lands. They (Rohingya) have created a pressure on the life, livelihoods and peaceful living of host community people.

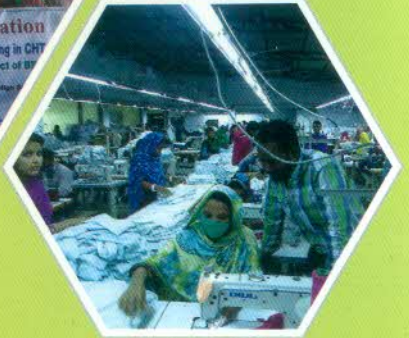
Indicators

- 50% (500) of targeted host community HH shows 30% increase of income at the third year of project.
- 30% agricultural production increased at the second year of project.
- 50% (500) targeted HH are shown Households Dietary Diversity (HDD) of four food groups.
- 50% conflict will be reported and out of which 30% will be resolved by the facilitation of project communities and committees.
- No. of trained women, youths and local leaders are able to prevent and mitigate conflicts, building social cohesion, peace and security.



Indicators.....

- No. of children and youths in the host communities received adequate support to reduce stress, tension and develop confidence.
- 100% of the targeted host HH have received training and start up support to conduct small scale agriculture at homestead and fellow lands.
- 120 Host family members have received training on vocational trades and start continues their income out of these activities.
- 50% conflict will be reported and out of which 30% will be resolved by the facilitation of project communities and committees.
- Family Peace Counsellors -(FPCs) are able to prevent and mitigate conflicts, building social cohesion, peace and security.
